In line with NATO policy and doctrine, MMCC-E intends to become an official supporting entity in the field of Medical Support for NATO and EU.


MMCC-E <u>acts complementary to existing NATO / EU structures</u>. The work of the MMCC-E supports the readiness and interoperability efforts of the nations within the framework of alliance defense.

<u>MMCC-E</u> provides coordinating efforts and outputs with direct operational effect in the following core tasks for the **nations** and NATO/EU standing military Command and Control structures in the area of medical support:

- Supporting multinational medical coordination efforts
- Improving readiness of medical C3 and preparedness through exercising and wargaming;
- > Improving medical civil-military interaction and networking;
- Coordinating medical capability enhancement on request of nations and organizations.



Patient % by Status of evacuation




% of Patients by Civ-Mil Status



Patients by Requesting country




Patients by Diagnosis
